



YOUTH WORKER

Tregear Presbyterian Community Church is looking for a godly, gifted and enthusiastic disciple-maker to join our pastoral team and help develop our youth ministry. The church has operated in the Mt Druitt area for over 50 years and, with our Preschool, has sought to be a light to, and serve, our community.

This is an exciting opportunity for someone who has a desire to help our young people grow in their love for the Lord and one another, so that they are equipped to serve the Lord and reach out and connect with young people in the community for Christ.

RESPONSIBILITIES

There is flexibility to shape the role to suit the giftings and passions of the right leader. But we would envisage that these might be some of the things the right person would be involved in:

- Build and maintain effective relationships with the young people of the church and care for them pastorally.
- Run and promote a youth group for both youth in the church and for reaching youth in the area.
- Work with families of young people, equipping parents to disciple their children.
- Involvement at Chifley College Campus teaching SRE and participating in other school - based activities as opportunities allow.
- Look for ways to involve young people in our church service.
- Develop young people to be faith filled followers of Jesus.

EXPERIENCE AND ROLE EXPECTATIONS

The successful candidate will:

- Be able to demonstrate a solid faith in Jesus Christ, be a committed member of a church, and support the doctrines of the Presbyterian Church.
- Have a current WWCC and be prepared to complete the mandatory Breaking The Silence training of the Presbyterian Church, along with training to be an SRE teacher if not completed already.
- Preferably have completed or be undertaking biblical studies or youth leadership training.
- Preferably have been involved in ministry to young people.
- Be willing to be part of our church community.
- Be accountable to the church leadership team and function as part of the ministry team of our church.

The role is offered on a part-time basis for 20 hours per week – days to be negotiated. Remuneration will be based on the Presbyterian Church's set packages.

The initial contract will be for a period of 2 years, inclusive of a 6-month probation period. Ideally the role will extend beyond that timeframe, subject to the needs of the church and the successful inclusion of this role into the ministry team.
